The Nova Scotia Off Road Riders Association (NSORRA) is a volunteer-driven non-profit organization formed to promote and represent the safe, family friendly and environmentally responsible sport of off-road motorcycling. The Association provides off-road motorcyclists with the resources required to ensure safe and responsible enjoyment of Nova Scotia's wondrous natural resources while meeting requirements set out in the Off Highway Vehicles Act.

NSORRA SERVICES:

- **INFORMATION & RESOURCES:** NSORRA's website, www.offroadriders.ca, offers information on a range of topics related to off-road riding in Nova Scotia.
- **TRAINING:** Our certified coaches meet national standards for teaching people aged 6 and up the principles and behaviors of safe and responsible off-highway motorcycle riding. All riders under the age 16 require training as of Oct 1st 2008. As of April 1st 2012 all riders are required to pass an off-road riders test.
- **EVENTS:** NSORRA organizes formal and informal ride events for members throughout the riding season.

- **ADVOCACY:** NSORRA is the coordinated voice for Nova Scotia off-highway motorcycle riders with government, media, industry and the public.
- **DISCUSSION FORUMS:** An open internet forum allows the rider community to discuss issues, learn about riding opportunities, and get involved.
