NSORRA is working with Lunenburg Municipality to make a new riding area in New Germany suitable for our riders.

NSORRA has been included in a new agreement with ATAVANS and the NS Deptment of the Environment for trails in Wilderness Protected areas in Nova Scotia.

NSORRA will be part of the upcoming pilot project on the BLT trail in HRM to develop a process for deciding OHV access to trails in HRM. We are also looking at recently Purchased lands by the Dept of Natural Resources as possible future riding areas and are looking at the Windsor/ Gypsum Line as a riding area for our members
